




Fall Polices and Procedures for Safe Opening



Drop Off and Pick up

- Parent/Guardian must accompany the student to check in on your first visit to sign (or turn in) our new Studio C waiver.
- On each subsequent visit, parent/guardians may remain in the car if the student is old enough to answer screening questions. Students needing assistance may have a responsible party join them for screening.
- Our lobby will be used for our students breaks. Although, one parent of any child of the ages between 2-8 may come in and wait if you feel it is necessary.
- The dancers break room now has a limit of individuals who may store items in the room.
- All Parents/Guardians of students are encouraged to wait in their cars on the premises.
- Parents/Guardians for the age 2-3 acro class may take the class with their child as long as they are masked. Please limit one parent per student.
- Dancers must arrive dressed and ready to dance. Use cover ups when needed. Bring only your dance items needed for that day.



Health Screening/Contact Tracing

- Every screening will be performed by a Studio C Staff member at the front door.
- Staff, students and any parent staying for the age 2-3 acro class will be temperature screened using a non contact thermometer.
- Anyone with a cough, difficulty breathing, or fever are not permitted to enter the studio.
- Anyone who has traveled outside the U.S. territory in the last 14 days or that visited a hot spot may not enter the studio.
- Anyone who has been in contact with a person with a lab confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days may not enter the studio.
- Attendance will be taken in every class to facilitate contact tracing.

PROTECTING YOUR STUDENT

- The entire facility will be sanitized daily with a fogger.
- Staff will sanitize each dance room before and after each class including entryways, ballet barres and any other touch surface.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the studio. Soap and paper towel dispensers will be filled daily.

TAKE NOTE

- Parents can decide if your child needs to wear a mask during class.
- Parents in and out the studio will need to wear masks.
- Masks are not provided.
- All Dancers are encouraged to wear masks during breaks.
- Dancers breaks will be monitored to minimize large group gatherings.
- The "lost and found" box has been removed. No items are allowed to be left in the studio overnight.

REMINDERS

- If you or your child is ill, please stay home.
- If you or your child have an underlying health condition, please take extra precautions given to you by your physician.
- Maintain practice social distancing in all areas at Studio C
- Dancers are encouraged to wear masks during breaks. No food will be allowed in the studio. Please bring a water bottle from home that is marked with your dancers name.

DURING CLASS

- Class formats have been modified to omit activity that would require contact between dancers.
- Dancers will be encouraged to keep social distancing during each class.
- Each studio has been marked for dancer social distancing.
- Teachers will wear masks when possible while instructing.

Hand Sanitizer



Hand Sanitizer will be applied to each dancer when entering the studio and before each class.

Temperatures will be taken upon arrival to the studio.
